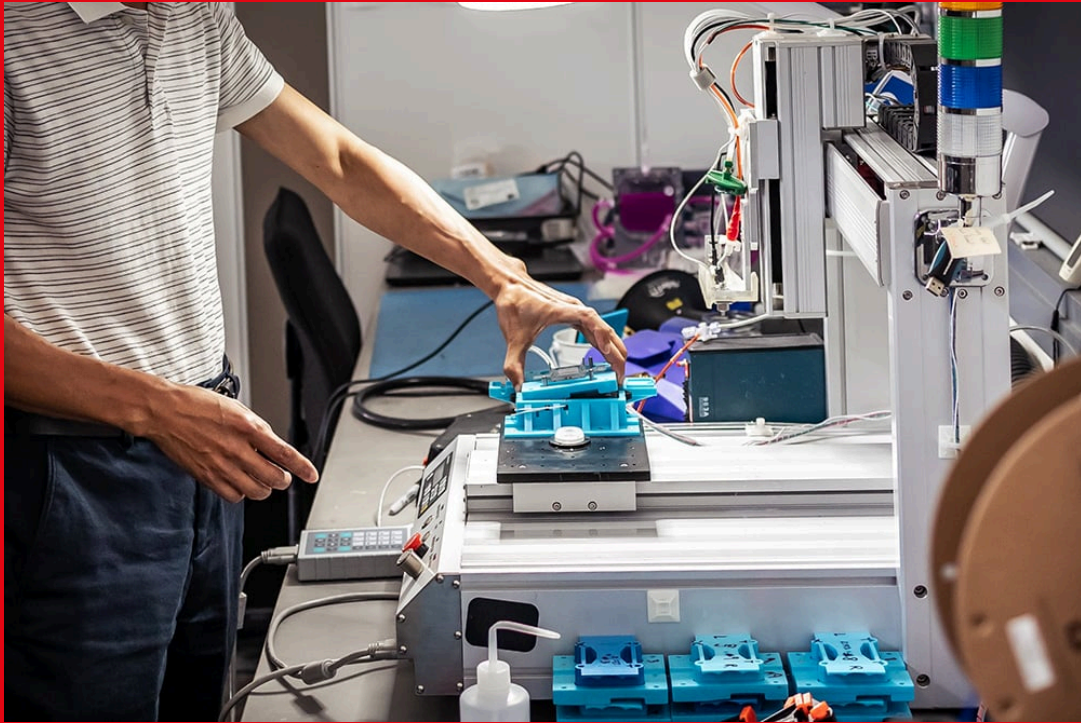
SYOS Aerospace completes fully autonomous trials – a major milestone in uncrewed aviation.

SYOS Aerospace has reached a major milestone, successfully completing a series of fully autonomous mission trials of its SA200 heavy-lift uncrewed helicopter, clearing the aircraft for serial production. The achievement marks the culmination of a five-year development programme and represents a significant step forward for maritime and expeditionary autonomy.

During testing, the SA200 demonstrated fully autonomous take-off and landing from a moving platform, replicating ship-borne and vehicle-based operations – one of the most technically demanding challenges in autonomous flight. The aircraft is designed to independently complete complex missions without human operation.

Powered by SYOS's AAIMS autonomy stack, the SA200 is designed to deliver a best-in-market cost-to-capability ratio and is now ready to move into serial production.

Veriphi is revolutionising IV medication safety with next-generation CAV4 Analyser.

New Zealand MedTech company Veriphi is set to launch its next-generation CAV4 Analyser at the Digital Health Festival in Melbourne this May. Using lasers, cloud connectivity and artificial intelligence, the device verifies intravenous (IV) drug identity and concentration to help prevent medication errors. Developed from trials at St Vincent's Hospital Melbourne, the CAV4 incorporates real-world insights, enhanced software functionality, and a fully integrated, self-contained design. With over 300 hospital tests completed and a growing drug data library, Veriphi is now planning expansion internationally, building a recurring revenue model to support safer IV medication delivery at global scale.

2025 was a busy year for TIN, with a calendar of report launches and member events that brought together members, sponsors, and the wider tech sector.

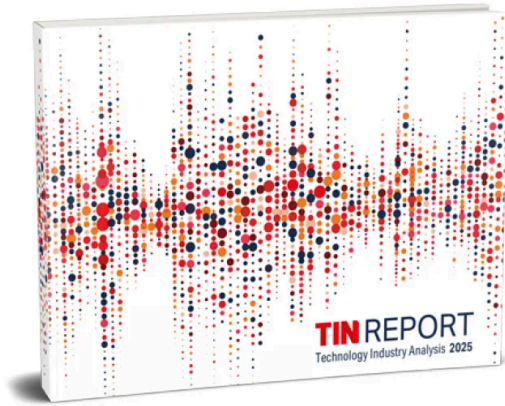
